NEEDLES—

Patons Beehive or Queen Bee Knitting Needles—

Loose Knitters:

1 pair each Nos. 10 and 13.

Average Knitters:

1 pair each Nos. 9 and 12.

Tight Knitters:

1 pair each Nos. 8 and 11.

Needle sizes in instructions are those for Average Knitters.

Needle size depends upon your tension, which should be $13\frac{1}{2}$ stitches to 2 inches in width, measured over plain smooth fabric. Check tension—see page 67.

Length from top of shoulder—

Size A .. $25\frac{1}{2}$ ins. Size B .. 26 ins.

Size C $26\frac{1}{2}$ ins.

Length of sleeve seam—

All Sizes, 20 ins. (or length desired).

One Stitch Holder.

Three Medium Buttons.

ABBREVIATIONS: See page 67.

Instructions are for smallest size **A**. Larger sizes **B** and **C** are shown thus [B—...] [C—...]. Where one set of figures is given, this applies to all sizes.

THE FRONT—Using No. 12 Needles, cast on 131 [B—141] [C—151] stitches.

1st row.—K.2, * P.1, K.1, rep. from * to last st., K.1.

2nd row.—* K.1, P.1, rep. from * to last st., K.1.

Rep. 1st and 2nd rows six times.

Using No. 9 Needles, proceed as follows:

1st row.—Knit. **2nd row.**—Purl.

Continue in plain smooth fabric until work measures 17 ins. from commencement, finishing with a purl row. Shape for armholes by casting off 2 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

Next row.—K.3, slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o.,

Next row.—Purl.

knit to last 5 sts., K.2 tog., K.3.

Continue dec. in this manner in next and every alt. row until 111 [B—121] [C—131] sts. remain. **

Work 1 row.

Divide for front opening as follows:

Next row.—K.3, slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.45 [B—K.50] [C—K.55], turn.

Continue on these 49 [B—54] [C—59] sts., dec. once at armhole edge as before in every alt. row until 31 [B—36] [C—38] sts. remain.

Shape neck as follows:

1st row.—P.2 tog., purl to end of row.

2nd row.—K.3, slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., knit to last 2 sts., K.2 tog.

Rep. 1st and 2nd rows five [B—six] [C—six] times.

(13 [B—15] [C—17] sts.)

Continue dec. once at armhole edge only as before in every alt. row until 8 [B—12] [C—14] sts. remain.

Work 1 row without shaping.

Proceed as follows:

1st row.—K.3, slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., knit to end of row.

2nd row.—Purl to last 5 sts., P.2 tog.t.b.l., P.3.

Size A only—3rd row.—As 1st row. (5 sts.)

[Sizes B and C only—Rep. 1st and 2nd rows [B—twice] [C—three times] then 1st row once. (5 sts.)]

All Sizes—Proceed as follows:

1st row.—P.2 tog.t.b.l., P.3.

2nd row.—K.2, slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o.

3rd row.—P.2 tog.t.b.l., P.1.

4th row.—K.2 tog. Fasten off.

Slip next 11 sts. on stitch holder and leave.

Join in yarn at neck edge and work on remaining sts. to correspond with other side, working "P.2 tog." in place of "P.2 tog.t.b.l."

THE BACK—Work as given for Front to **.

Continue dec. once at each end of needle as before in every alt. row until 49 [B—61] [C—65] sts. remain.

Next row.—P.3, P.2 tog., purl to last 5 sts., P.2 tog.t.b.l., P.3.

Continue dec. at each end of needle as before in every row until 37 [B—41] [C—41] sts. remain. Cast off.

THE SLEEVES—Using No. 12 Needles

cast on 63 [B—71] [C—79] stitches.
1st row.—K.2, * P.1, K.1, rep. from *
to last st., K.1.

2nd row.—K.1, * P.1, K.1, rep from *
to end of row.

Rep. 1st and 2nd rows fourteen times,
then 1st row once.

32nd row. — Rib 3 [B—rib 7]
[C—rib 11], (inc. once in next st.,
rib 10) five times, inc. once in next

st., rib 4 [B—rib 8] [C—rib 12].
(69 [B—77] [C—85] sts.)

Using No. 9 Needles, proceed as
follows:

1st row.—Knit. **2nd row.**—Purl.

Continue in plain smooth fabric, inc.
once at each end of needle in next
and every following 8th row until there
are 101 [B—109] [C—117] sts. on
needle.

Continue without shaping until side edge measures 20 ins. (or length desired) from commencement, finishing with a purl row.

Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

Next row.—K.3, slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., knit to last 5 sts., K.2 tog., K.3.

Next row.—Purl.

Continue dec. once at each end of needle in next and every alt. row as before until 13 [B—25] [C—25] sts. remain.

[Sizes B and C only—

Next row.—P.3, P.2 tog., purl to last 5 sts., P.2 tog.t.b.l., P.3.

Next row.—K.3, slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., knit to last 5 sts., K.2 tog., K.3.

Continue dec. in every row as before until 13 sts. remain.]

All Sizes.—Cast off.

Work another Sleeve in same manner.

THE LEFT FRONT BAND.—Slip sts. left on stitch holder on to a No. 12 Needle, so that right side of work is

facing when working 1st row.

Using No. 12 Needles, proceed as follows:

1st row.—K.2 * P.1, K.1, rep. from * to last st., K.1.

2nd row.—K.1, * P.1, K.1, rep. from * to end of row.

Rep. 1st and 2nd rows four times.

11th row.—Rib 4, cast off 3 sts., rib 4.

12th row.—Rib 4, cast on 3 sts., rib 4. Continue in rib, making a buttonhole as before in every following 13th and 14th rows from previous buttonhole until 3 buttonholes in all have been worked.

Work 6 rows in rib. Cast off in rib.

THE RIGHT FRONT BAND.—Using No. 12 Needles, cast on 11 stitches.

1st row.—K.2, * P.1, K.1, rep. from * to last st., K.1.

2nd row.—K.1, * P.1, K.1, rep. from * to end of row.

Rep. 1st and 2nd rows twenty-two times. Cast off in rib.

THE COLLAR.—Using No. 12 Needles, cast on 213 [B—223] [C—233] sts.

1st row.—K.2, * P.1, K.1, rep. from * to last st., K.1.

2nd row.—K.1, * P.1, K.1, rep. from * to end of row.

Rep. 1st and 2nd rows twelve [B—fourteen] [C—sixteen] times.

Next row.—Cast off 8 sts., rib 6 [B—rib 8] [C—rib 10], * (work 2 tog.)

twice, rib 2, rep. from * to last 19 [B—21] [C—23] sts., (work 2 tog.)

twice, rib 15 [B—rib 17] [C—rib 19]. (143 [B—151] [C—159] sts.)

Cast off 8 sts. at beg. of next 9 rows. (71 [B—79] [C—87] sts.)

Cast off remaining sts.

TO MAKE UP.—With a slightly damp cloth and warm iron, press lightly. Using a flat seam for ribbing and a fine back-stitch seam for other seams, sew up side and sleeve seams. Using a fine back-stitch seam, sew sleeves to front and back, noting that tops of sleeves form part of neckline. Using a fine back-stitch seam, sew front bands and underlap in position. Using a flat seam, sew collar to neckline, commencing and finishing at centre front opening. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes. Finally, press all seams.
